Association Policies Regulation

1. Establishment

- 1.1. The Council and Committee may from time to time make, adopt, vary and repeal all such Policies consistent with the Rules and Regulations of the association as shall be thought expedient and desirable for the internal management, well-being and good repute of the association and of its members
- **1.2.** Each such policy shall be brought before the Council or Committee upon due notice to each member thereof prior to the meeting at which it is first to be considered.
- 1.3. Each such policy so adopted shall be published to each Branch and each band currently registered with the association under the title "[name] Policy of Pipe Bands Australia Inc".

2. Compliance

- 2.1. The association, its branches and its members and employees shall observe each such Policy during and in relation to all activities of the association and its members, but this shall not include the functions or activities of a band currently or formerly registered with the association or any activity of persons being members of the association but which is not related to its aims, objects or activities.
- 2.2. A reported breach of a Policy shall be promptly investigated by the Branch within whose activities it is alleged to have occurred, or, when appropriate, by the Committee of the association. A Branch shall promptly report each such investigation to the Committee.
- 2.3. The Committee on concluding such an investigation or considering such a report from a Branch may consider and deal with any reported breach of this regulation, including any reported breach of an adopted association Policy, in the manner prescribed in Rule 11 of the Rules of the association.
